Handicaps

All members taking part in any internal competition should keep a handicap card and make these available to the club's handicapper (Ian Parkinson-Golf Croquet, Mark Homan-Association Croquet). There are separate cards for association (White) and golf croquet (green) and handicap lists in the hut.

All Single games in the CA Fixtures, Federation Leagues, inter club contests (including friendlies) and internal Club Competitions qualify for this system. Short croquet, doubles, friendly club games, walkovers and abandon games are excluded from this system.

As well as trying to ensure that you are fairly treated in the club's own competitions, the handicappers act as the club's conscience in ensuring the club's reputation for fair

handicapping of its teams. If you are in doubt please discuss it with the relevant handicapper **Internal Competition Champions**
